 lots; defining <u>a</u> certain terms term; and generally relating to septie <u>on-site</u>

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 ZONE, RURAL DENSITY TRANSFER ZONE, <u>RURAL NEIGHBORHOOD CLUSTER</u>
6 <u>ZONE</u>, OR RURAL SERVICE ZONE AS DESCRIBED IN THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY
7 CODE ZONING ORDINANCE.

27(III)ONLYONEON-SITESEWAGEDISPOSALSYSTEM28EASEMENT MAY SERVE ONLY ONE SUBDIVIDED LOT OR PARCEL.

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1 (C) A SEPTIC SYSTEM OR WELL UNDER SUBSECTION (B) (B)(1) OF THIS 2 SECTION MAY NOT:

3 (1) SERVE LAND THAT IS DESIGNATED BY THE STATE OR THE 4 GOVERNING BODY OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY AS A SPECIAL PROTECTION AREA 5 OR GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE; OR

6 (2) DECREASE THE LAND AVAILABLE FOR AGRICULTURAL 7 PRODUCTION BY MORE THAN 4,000 SQUARE FEET.

8 (D) THIS SECTION DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE CREATION OF ANY 9 ADDITIONAL LOTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 October July 1, 2011.
