BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 23MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Election Law 24251 - 101.

2 (A) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO GOVERN 3 VOTING BY MAIL.

4 (B) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE 5 FOR:

6 (1) THE USE OF A VOTING SYSTEM SELECTED AND CERTIFIED 7 UNDER § 9–101 OF THIS TITLE;

- 8 (2) UNIFORMITY OF THE VOTING-BY-MAIL PROCESS;
- 9 (3) THE MAILING OF BALLOTS TO VOTERS;
- 10 (4) REPLACEMENT BALLOT PROCEDURES;

11(5) THE VOTER'S RESPONSIBILITIES REGARDING THE12VOTING-BY-MAIL PROCESS;

13(6) THE HANDLING AND COUNTING OF BALLOTS RECEIVED BY14THE LOCAL BOARDS;

15(7) REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES THAT ASSURE16COMPLIANCE WITH THE HELP AMERICA VOTE ACT OF 2002; AND

17 (8) REQUIREMENTS AND CRITERIA FOR THE DESIGNATION OF
18 PLACES OF DEPOSIT FOR THE BALLOTS CAST IN THE SPECIAL ELECTION,
19 INCLUDING THE DATES AND TIMES THE PLACES OF DEPOSIT MUST BE OPEN AND
20 THE SECURITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PLACES OF DEPOSIT.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2011.
