AN ACT concerning

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Polysomnography – Technologists and Technicians – Licensing Requirements <u>Licensure</u>

FOR the purpose of establishing a polysomnographic technician license; requiring the State Board of Physicians to set certain fees regarding the licensing of polysomnographic technicians; altering the duties of the Polysomnography Professional Standards Committee: altering certain education requirements to qualify for a polysomnographic technologist license; providing for the qualifications for a polysomnographic technician license; requiring the Board to waive certain education requirements for certain applicants for a polysomnographic technologist license under certain circumstances; providing that a certain applicant who qualified for a polysomnographic technician license under certain circumstances is entitled to be licensed for a single term under certain circumstances; providing for the scope of a license to practice polysomnography as a polysomnographic technician; prohibiting the Board from renewing the license of a polysomnographic technician; prohibiting a licensed polysomnographic technician from surrendering or allowing a license to lapse under certain circumstances: defining certain terms; making certain conforming changes extending the date by which an individual is required to be licensed by the State Board of Physicians before the individual may practice polysomnography in the State; extending the date on or before which the Board is required to waive a certain education requirement for certain individuals; extending the date by which certain individuals may petition the Board for a certain extension; and generally relating to licensing requirements for polysomnographic technologists and technicians.
