## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Procurement - State Buildings - Energy Efficient Outdoor Lighting Fixtures

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the use of State funds to install or replace a permanent outdoor luminaire for lighting on the grounds of any State building 4 5 unless the luminaire meets certain requirements; providing certain exceptions 6 to the requirements of this Act; authorizing the Board of Public Works or the 7 Board's designee to waive the requirements of this Act under certain 8 circumstances; requiring the Board to establish the requirements for a certain 9 waiver request; requiring the Board or the Board's designee to consider certain 10 factors when considering a waiver request; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the use of energy efficient outdoor lighting fixtures on 11 State buildings. 12

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 22 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 23 MEANINGS INDICATED.
- 24 (2) "LAMP" MEANS THE COMPONENT OF A LUMINAIRE THAT 25 PRODUCES THE LIGHT.

- 4 (2) THE ILLUMINATION PRODUCED BY THE LUMINAIRE IS THE 5 MINIMUM ILLUMINATION NECESSARY FOR THE INTENDED PURPOSE OF THE 6 LIGHTING; AND
- 7 (3) FOR A LUMINAIRE WITH AN OUTPUT OF MORE THAN 1,800 8 LUMENS, THE LUMINAIRE IS A RESTRICTED UPLIGHT LUMINAIRE.
- 9 (D) (1) THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OR THE BOARD'S DESIGNEE
  10 MAY WAIVE THE REQUIREMENT OF SUBSECTION (C)(3) OF THIS SECTION IF,
  11 AFTER A REQUEST FOR A WAIVER HAS BEEN MADE, THE BOARD OF PUBLIC
  12 WORKS OR THE BOARD'S DESIGNEE DETERMINES THAT THE WAIVER IS
  13 NECESSARY FOR THE LIGHTING APPLICATION.
- 14 (2) THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS SHALL ESTABLISH THE 15 REQUIREMENTS FOR A WAIVER REQUEST UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 16 SUBSECTION, INCLUDING:
- 17 (I) A DESCRIPTION OF THE LIGHTING PLAN;
- 18 (II) A DESCRIPTION OF THE EFFORTS MADE TO COMPLY
  19 WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION; AND
- 20 (III) THE REASON A WAIVER IS NECESSARY.
- 21 (3) IN REVIEWING A WAIVER REQUEST, THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OR THE BOARD'S DESIGNEE SHALL CONSIDER DESIGN SAFETY, COSTS, 23 AND ANY OTHER FACTORS THE BOARD OR THE BOARD'S DESIGNEE DETERMINES ARE APPROPRIATE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
