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Equity in Education Funding Act of 2011

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 (a) (9) "Net taxable income" means the amount certified by the State 2 Comptroller for the second completed calendar year before the school year for which 3 the calculation of State aid under this section is made, based on tax returns filed on or 4 before September 1 after this calendar year.

5 (A-1) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING THE DEFINITION OF NET TAXABLE 6 INCOME UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013 AND 7 EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, NET TAXABLE INCOME SHALL BE CALCULATED BASED 8 ON TAX RETURNS FILED ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1 AND NOVEMBER 1.

9 (2) THE CALCULATION THAT RESULTS IN THE GREATER AMOUNT 10 OF STATE AID FOR EACH COUNTY SHALL BE USED TO CALCULATE STATE AID 11 FOR EDUCATION PROGRAMS THAT USE WEALTH TO CALCULATE THE FORMULAS.

12 (3) THE ALLOCATION OF ANY ADDITIONAL STATE AID THAT 13 RESULTS FROM THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE TWO CALCULATIONS SHALL BE 14 PHASED IN PROPORTIONALLY TO THE EXTENT FUNDS ARE PROVIDED IN THE 15 STATE BUDGET, PROVIDED THAT NO JURISDICTION SHALL RECEIVE LESS 16 STATE AID FOR EDUCATION PROGRAMS THAT USE WEALTH TO CALCULATE THE 17 FORMULAS THAN THE AMOUNT RECEIVED IN THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR AS A 18 RESULT OF THE CALCULATIONS UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 July 1, 2011, and shall be applicable to the calculation of payments of State aid for 21 education for fiscal years beginning after June 30, 2012.
