3	FOR the purpose of altering the distributions of video lottery terminal proceeds from a						
4	video lottery facility in Allegany County under certain circumstances; repealing						
5	certain provisions relating to a distribution of video lottery terminal proceeds to						
6	a video lottery operation licensee in Allegany County that would otherwise go to						
7	the Racetrack Facility Renewal Account; making this Act an emergency						
8	measure; and generally relating to video lottery terminals and video lottery						
9	terminal proceeds.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 19 (a) [On] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, 20 ON a properly approved transmittal prepared by the Commission, the Comptroller 21 shall pay the following amounts from the proceeds of video lottery terminals at each 22 video lottery facility:
- 23 (1) 2% to the State Lottery Agency for costs as defined in § 9–1A–01 of this subtitle;

MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:



- 1 (2) [except as provided in subsection (b) of this section,] to the video lottery operation licensee, the percentage stated in the accepted application for the location, not to exceed 33%;
- 4 (3) 5.5% in local impact grants, in accordance with § 9-1A-31 of this 5 subtitle;
- 6 (4) 7% to the Purse Dedication Account established under § 9–1A–28 of this subtitle, not to exceed a total of \$100,000,000 to the Account annually;
- 8 (5) [(i) except as provided in item (ii) of this item,] for the first 8 years of operations at a video lottery facility, 2.5% to the Racetrack Facility Renewal 10 Account established under § 9–1A–29 of this subtitle, not to exceed a total of \$40,000,000 to the Account annually;
- [(ii) for the first 5 years of operations at a video lottery facility in Allegany County, 2.5% to the video lottery operation licensee that satisfies the requirement under subsection (b) of this section;
- 15 (6) 1.5% to the Small, Minority, and Women–Owned Businesses 16 Account established under § 9–1A–35 of this subtitle; and
- 17 (7) the remainder to the Education Trust Fund established under § 9–1A–30 of this subtitle.
- 19 **(1)** For the first 5 years of operations at a video lottery facility in 20 Allegany County, the Comptroller shall pay to the video lottery operation licensee, on 21a properly approved transmittal prepared by the Commission, the percentages 22authorized in subsection (a)(2) and (5)(ii) of this section as stated in the accepted 23application for the location, if the applicant that is awarded the video lottery operation 24license agrees to purchase the Rocky Gap Lodge and Resort] SUBJECT TO 25 THIS SUBSECTION, ON A PROPERLY APPROVED PARAGRAPH (2) OF 26 TRANSMITTAL PREPARED BY THE COMMISSION, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL PAY 27 THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS FROM THE PROCEEDS OF VIDEO LOTTERY 28 TERMINALS AT A VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY IN ALLEGANY COUNTY:
- 29 (I) 1% TO THE STATE LOTTERY AGENCY FOR COSTS AS 30 DEFINED IN § 9–1A–01 OF THIS SUBTITLE;
- 31 (II) TO THE VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSEE, THE 32 PERCENTAGE STATED IN THE ACCEPTED APPLICATION FOR THE LOCATION, NOT TO EXCEED 50%;
- 34 (III) 2.75% IN LOCAL IMPACT GRANTS, IN ACCORDANCE 35 WITH § 9–1A–31 OF THIS SUBTITLE;

- 3 (V) 0.75% TO THE SMALL, MINORITY, AND WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESSES ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED UNDER § 9-1A-35 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- 5 (VI) The remainder to the Education Trust Fund 6 established under § 9–1A–30 of this subtitle.
- 7 (2) IF THE PROCEEDS GENERATED FROM VIDEO LOTTERY
 8 TERMINALS AT A VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY IN ALLEGANY COUNTY ARE EQUAL
 9 TO OR EXCEED THE AVERAGE VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINAL PROCEEDS
 10 GENERATED AT THE OTHER VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITIES IN THE STATE, AS
 11 DETERMINED BY THE STATE LOTTERY COMMISSION, THEN THE PROCEEDS
 12 GENERATED AT THE FACILITY IN ALLEGANY COUNTY SHALL BE ALLOCATED AS
 13 PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
