A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Attorney Grievance Commission – Surplus Funds and Budget Procedures**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring any unspent portions of the Disciplinary Fund of the
4 Attorney Grievance Commission to revert to the General Fund of the State;
5 requiring the Commission to submit its budget each year to the Department of
6 Budget and Management; and generally relating to the Attorney Grievance
7 Commission.

9 Article – Business Occupations and Professions
10 Section 10–503
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (2010 Replacement Volume)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

16 **10–503.**

17 **(A) ANY UNSPENT PORTIONS OF THE DISCIPLINARY FUND OF THE**
18 **ATTORNEY GRIEVANCE COMMISSION SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND**
19 **OF THE STATE.**

20 **(B) THE ATTORNEY GRIEVANCE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT ITS**
21 **BUDGET EACH YEAR TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT.**

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 July 1, 2011.
