17 (A) ANY UNSPENT PORTIONS OF THE DISCIPLINARY FUND OF THE 18 ATTORNEY GRIEVANCE COMMISSION SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND 19 OF THE STATE.

20 (B) THE ATTORNEY GRIEVANCE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT ITS 21 BUDGET EACH YEAR TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT.
