1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Driver's License Applications – Cosigner for Minors – Department of Social**
3 **Services**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a driver's license application of a minor who is
5 committed to the custody or guardianship of a local department of social
6 services to be signed by the director of the department or the director's designee;
7 and generally relating to driver's license applications of minors.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Transportation**

16 16–107.

17 (a) The application of a minor for a license shall be cosigned by:

18 (1) A parent or guardian of the applicant; [or]

1 (2) If the applicant has no parent or guardian or is married, an adult
2 employer of the applicant or any other responsible adult; OR

3 (3) IF THE APPLICANT IS COMMITTED TO THE CUSTODY OR
4 GUARDIANSHIP OF A LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES, THE DIRECTOR
5 OF THE DEPARTMENT OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE.

6 (b) The individual cosigning the application of a minor shall:

7 (1) (i) Provide the cosigner's mailing address to the
8 Administration; and

9 (ii) Within 30 days of any change in the mailing address
10 occurring while the applicant or licensee is a minor, notify the Administration of the
11 change; and

12 (2) Certify that the statements made in the application are true to the
13 best of the cosigner's knowledge, information, and belief.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 October 1, 2011.
