## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Housing - Discrimination Based on Source of Income - Prohibitions

FOR the purpose of altering the housing policy of the State to provide for fair housing to all citizens regardless of source of income; prohibiting a person from refusing to sell or rent a dwelling to any person because of source of income; prohibiting a person from discriminating against any person in the terms, conditions, or privileges of sale or rental of a dwelling because of source of income; prohibiting a person from making, printing, or publishing certain types of materials with respect to the sale or rental of a dwelling that indicate a preference, limitation, or discrimination on the basis of source of income; prohibiting a person from falsely representing that a dwelling is not available for inspection, sale, or rental based on source of income; prohibiting a person from, for profit, inducing or attempting to induce a person to sell or rent a dwelling by making certain representations relating to the entry or prospective entry into the neighborhood of a person of a particular source of income; prohibiting a person whose business includes engaging in residential real estate transactions from discriminating against any person in making available a transaction, or in the terms or conditions of a transaction, because of source of income; prohibiting a person, based on source of income, from denying a person access to or membership or participation in a service, organization, or facility relating to the business of selling or renting dwellings, or to discriminate against a person in the terms or conditions of membership; prohibiting a person from, by force or threat of force, willfully injuring, intimidating, or interfering with any person because of source of income and because the person is negotiating for the sale or rental of any dwelling or participating in any service relating to the business of selling or renting dwellings; altering a certain definition; defining a certain term; defining a certain term as it applies to rental transactions; and generally relating to prohibitions against discrimination in housing based on source of income.

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- (a) It is the policy of the State:
- 5 (1) to provide for fair housing throughout the State to all, regardless of 6 race, color, religion, sex, familial status, national origin, marital status, sexual 7 orientation, [or] disability, OR SOURCE OF INCOME; and
- 8 (2) to that end, to prohibit discriminatory practices with respect to residential housing by any person, in order to protect and insure the peace, health, safety, prosperity, and general welfare of all.

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- Except as provided in §§ 20–703 and 20–704 of this subtitle, a person may not:
- 13 (1) refuse to sell or rent after the making of a bona fide offer, refuse to 14 negotiate for the sale or rental of, or otherwise make unavailable or deny, a dwelling to 15 any person because of race, color, religion, sex, disability, marital status, familial 16 status, sexual orientation, [or] national origin, OR SOURCE OF INCOME;
- 17 (2) discriminate against any person in the terms, conditions, or 18 privileges of the sale or rental of a dwelling, or in the provision of services or facilities 19 in connection with the sale or rental of a dwelling, because of race, color, religion, sex, 20 disability, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, [or] national origin, OR 21 SOURCE OF INCOME;
  - (3) make, print, or publish, or cause to be made, printed, or published, any notice, statement, or advertisement with respect to the sale or rental of a dwelling that indicates any preference, limitation, or discrimination based on race, color, religion, sex, disability, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, [or] national origin, OR SOURCE OF INCOME, or an intention to make any preference, limitation, or discrimination;
  - (4) represent to any person, because of race, color, religion, sex, disability, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, [or] national origin, OR SOURCE OF INCOME, that any dwelling is not available for inspection, sale, or rental when the dwelling is available; or
  - (5) for profit, induce or attempt to induce any person to sell or rent any dwelling by representations regarding the entry or prospective entry into the neighborhood of a person of a particular race, color, religion, sex, disability, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, [or] national origin, OR SOURCE OF INCOME.

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- 2 (a) In this section, "residential real estate-related transaction" means:
- 3 (1) the making or purchasing of loans or providing other financial 4 assistance:
- 5 (i) for purchasing, constructing, improving, repairing, or 6 maintaining a dwelling; or
- 7 (ii) secured by residential real estate; or
- 8 (2) the selling, brokering, or appraising of residential real property.
- 9 (b) (1) A person whose business includes engaging in residential real estate—related transactions may not discriminate against any person in making available a transaction, or in the terms or conditions of a transaction, because of race, color, religion, sex, disability, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, [or] national origin, OR SOURCE OF INCOME.
- 14 (2) Paragraph (1) of this subsection does not prohibit a person engaged 15 in the business of furnishing appraisals of real property from taking into consideration 16 factors other than race, color, religion, sex, disability, marital status, familial status, 17 sexual orientation, [or] national origin, OR SOURCE OF INCOME.

- 28 (c) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to:
- 30 (1) imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or a fine not exceeding \$1,000 31 or both;
- 32 (2) if the violation results in bodily injury, imprisonment not 33 exceeding 10 years or a fine not exceeding \$10,000 or both; or

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(3) if the violation results in death, imprisonment not exceeding life.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
