## Consumer Protection - Ceramic Fire Pots - Warning Label

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from selling or distributing a ceramic fire pot 4 unless a certain warning is printed legibly on the package or on a certain label; 5 requiring the State Fire Marshal to establish the form of a certain warning by 6 regulation; providing for the enforcement of this Act; providing that a person 7 who knowingly and willfully violates a certain provision of this Act is guilty of a 8 misdemeanor and subject to a fine not exceeding a certain amount; defining a 9 certain term; and generally relating to the sale and distribution of ceramic fire 10 pots.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

- 1 (c) (1) "Consumer" means an actual or prospective purchaser, lessee, or recipient of consumer goods, consumer services, consumer realty, or consumer credit.
- 3 (2) "Consumer" includes:
- 4 (i) A co-obligator or surety for a consumer; or
- 5 (ii) A licensee or recipient of computer information or computer 6 programs under a consumer contract as defined in § 22–102 of this article.
- 7 (e) "Division" means the Division of Consumer Protection of the Office of the 8 Attorney General.

- 10 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "CERAMIC FIRE POT" MEANS A PORTABLE
  11 CERAMIC CONTAINER THAT IS DESIGNED TO HOLD A FLAMMABLE LIQUID FUEL
  12 OR FLAMMABLE GELATINOUS FUEL AND IS MARKETED FOR USE BY CONSUMERS.
- 13 (2) "CERAMIC FIRE POT" DOES NOT INCLUDE A DEVICE USED FOR 14 COOKING.
- 15 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR DISTRIBUTE A CERAMIC FIRE POT
  16 UNLESS A CONSPICUOUS WARNING, IN THE FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE STATE
  17 FIRE MARSHAL, IS PRINTED LEGIBLY ON THE PACKAGING IN WHICH THE
  18 CERAMIC FIRE POT IS PLACED OR ON A LABEL SECURELY ATTACHED TO THE
  19 CERAMIC FIRE POT.
- 20 (C) THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL SHALL ESTABLISH BY REGULATION THE 21 FORM OF THE WARNING REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, 22 WHICH SHALL INCLUDE A STATEMENT REGARDING THE FIRE AND SAFETY 23 HAZARDS ASSOCIATED WITH THE USE OF CERAMIC FIRE POTS.
- 24 (D) (1) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AND THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL SHALL ENFORCE THIS SECTION UNDER THE ENFORCEMENT POWERS PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE AND IN THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE.
- 27 (2) THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF BALTIMORE CITY SHALL REPORT 28 TO THE DIVISION ANY VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION WHICH IT FINDS.
- 29 **(E)** ANY PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY VIOLATES THE 30 PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A 31 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING 32 \$5,000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
