19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 5–202(f), (g), and (h), respectively, of Article – Education 21 of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 5–202(g), (h), and 22 (i), respectively.

19 20 21 22 23	(2) IF A COUNTY BOARD'S TOTAL DIRECT EDUCATION AID IN THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR IS LESS THAN THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR BY MORE THAN 7%, THEN THE STATE SHALL PROVIDE A GRANT TO THE COUNTY BOARD IN AN AMOUNT NECESSARY TO ENSURE THAT A DECREASE IN TOTAL DIRECT EDUCATION AID IS NOT MORE THAN 7%.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, when the Maryland State Department of Education issues a contract to conduct a study of the adequacy of education funding in the State as required by Chapter 288 of 2002, the study shall include the impact on State funding of declining enrollments in local school systems with small enrollments.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2011. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of June 30, 2016, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

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
