(D) BY REGULATION, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ESTABLISH
 INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS THAT AN AUTHORIZED INSPECTION AGENCY MUST
 SATISFY BEFORE A SPECIAL INSPECTOR COMMISSION MAY BE ISSUED TO AN
 INSPECTOR EMPLOYED BY THE AUTHORIZED INSPECTION AGENCY.
