A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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State Lottery – Licenses – Veterans' Organizations

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Director of the State Lottery Agency to issue a license for not more than a certain number of lottery ticket terminals for the 4 $\mathbf{5}$ sale of State lottery tickets to veterans' organizations under certain 6 circumstances; requiring that a certain amount of revenues from lottery ticket $\mathbf{7}$ sales by a veterans' organization is to be provided for charitable purposes; 8 requiring that, after a certain date, a certain amount of revenues from lottery 9 ticket sales by a veterans' organization is to be distributed to the Maryland 10 Veterans Trust Fund; providing that certain revenues from lottery ticket sales by a veterans' organization are to be credited to the State Lottery Fund after 11 12certain distributions are made; requiring a veterans' organization issued a 13license under this Act to purchase or lease lottery ticket terminals; prohibiting a 14 veterans' organization from using certain lottery receipts to pay certain costs for lottery ticket terminals; directing the State Lottery Agency to implement the 15provisions of this Act in accordance with a certain court decision; and generally 16 17relating to the State lottery and State lottery ticket sales by veterans' 18 organizations.
