A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicle Administration – Selective Service Registration – Driver’s**
3 **License and Identification Card Applicants**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain provision making the Motor Vehicle
5 Administration’s collection and electronic forwarding of Selective Service
6 registration information on certain individuals to the Selective Service
7 Administration contingent on the Motor Vehicle Administration’s receipt of
8 federal funds to pay for certain start-up costs; repealing a certain provision
9 requiring the Motor Vehicle Administrator to initiate and monitor efforts to
10 obtain certain federal funds and to report to the Department of Legislative
11 Services when a certain contingency is fulfilled; and generally relating to the
12 Motor Vehicle Administration and Selective Service registration.

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

24 **Article – Transportation**

1 (a) This section applies only to an adult male applicant under the age of 26
2 years.

3 (b) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, the Administration shall provide
4 to the Selective Service Administration in an electronic format, for purposes of
5 registration with the Selective Service as required under federal law, the necessary
6 information concerning a male applicant who applies for a driver's license or
7 identification card or the renewal of a driver's license or identification card, including
8 the applicant's:

9 (1) Full name;

10 (2) Current address;

11 (3) Date of birth;

12 (4) Gender;

13 (5) Date of application; and

14 (6) Social Security number, if available.

15 (c) (1) A male applicant's signature on the application indicates that the
16 applicant has selected one of the options specified in paragraph (2) of this subsection
17 concerning Selective Service registration and the forwarding of information to the
18 Selective Service Administration under this section.

19 (2) In addition to the information required under this subtitle or Title
20 16 of this article, an application form for a driver's license or identification card or
21 renewal of a driver's license or identification card shall contain a statement that the
22 male applicant:

23 (i) Has already registered with the Selective Service
24 Administration; or

25 (ii) Has not registered with the Selective Service Administration
26 and:

27 1. Consents to forwarding the information in subsection
28 (b) of this section to the Selective Service Administration; or

29 2. Refuses to consent to the forwarding of the
30 information in subsection (b) of this section to the Selective Service Administration.

31 (d) Refusal to consent to the forwarding of the information in subsection (b)
32 of this section to the Selective Service Administration may not be grounds for denial of
33 an application for a driver's license or identification card or renewal of a driver's
34 license or identification card.

2 [SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act is
3 contingent on the receipt by the Motor Vehicle Administration of sufficient federal
4 funds to pay the Administration's initial start-up costs for computer programming
5 changes necessary to implement the requirements of Section 1 of this Act related to
6 the reporting of information to the Selective Service Administration.

7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Motor Vehicle
8 Administrator shall initiate and monitor efforts to obtain federal funds for the
9 purposes stated in Section 2 of this Act and shall report promptly to the Department of
10 Legislative Services when federal funds have been received by the Administration and
11 the contingency specified in Section 2 of this Act has been fulfilled.]

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2011.
