SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 12MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15(a) (1)Except as provided in paragraphs (2), (3), and (4) of this subsection, a person may not hunt any game bird or mammal on Sundays. 16

17(2)The following persons may hunt the specified game birds and mammals on Sundays: 18
