A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Financial Institutions – Automated Teller Machines – Video Cameras

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring each operator of a certain automated teller machine to 4 install and maintain a video camera that views and records certain activity of a 5 user of the automated teller machine; requiring the operator to preserve the 6 recordings made by the video camera for at least a certain number of days; 7 providing that a video camera need not record banking transactions made at an 8 automated teller machine; providing that an operator of a certain automated 9 teller machine is not in violation of certain provisions of this Act under certain 10 circumstances; providing that certain provisions of this Act do not apply to 11 certain automated teller machines under certain circumstances; providing that this Act applies only to automated teller machines first installed on or after a 12 13 certain date; and generally relating to automated teller machines.

- 24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 25 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Financial Institutions

- 2 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 3 (j) "Operator" means a financial institution or other person that operates an automated teller machine.
- 5 **1–402.1.**
- 6 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN AUTOMATED TELLER 7 MACHINE THAT IS:
- 8 (1) LOCATED INSIDE A BUILDING UNLESS:
- 9 (I) THE BUILDING IS A FREESTANDING INSTALLATION 10 THAT EXISTS SOLELY TO PROVIDE AN ENCLOSURE FOR THE AUTOMATED
- 11 TELLER MACHINE; OR
- 12 (II) A USER OF THE AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE IS ABLE
- 13 TO CONDUCT A TRANSACTION FROM OUTSIDE THE BUILDING; OR
- 14 (2) OPERATED BY A FINANCIAL INSTITUTION, UNLESS THE
- 15 AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE IS LOCATED AT OR WITHIN OR ATTACHED TO
- 16 PREMISES OWNED BY OR UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE FINANCIAL
- 17 INSTITUTION.
- 18 (B) EACH OPERATOR OF AN AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE SUBJECT TO
- 19 THIS SECTION SHALL:
- 20 (1) Install and maintain a video camera that views and
- 21 RECORDS ALL ACTIVITY OF A USER AS THE USER PERFORMS A TRANSACTION AT
- 22 THE AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE; AND
- 23 (2) Preserve the recordings made by the video camera
- 24 FOR AT LEAST 45 DAYS.
- 25 (C) A VIDEO CAMERA REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS
- 26 SECTION NEED NOT RECORD BANKING TRANSACTIONS MADE AT AN AUTOMATED
- 27 TELLER MACHINE.
- 28 (D) AN OPERATOR OF AN AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE SUBJECT TO
- 29 THIS SECTION IS NOT IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IF A VIDEO CAMERA
- 30 REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION MALFUNCTIONS DUE TO A
- 31 REASON NOT WITHIN THE OPERATOR'S CONTROL.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act applies only to automated teller machines first installed on or after October 1, 2011.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2011.
