 same transaction under certain circumstances; prohibiting the broker's designee
 from being a member of the real estate team under certain circumstances; and
 generally relating to intracompany agents providing real estate brokerage
 services.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 18 **(A)** A real estate broker **OR A DESIGNEE OF THE REAL ESTATE BROKER**19 may designate two members of a team as intracompany agents for the seller and the
 20 buyer in the same transaction if the parties have first been advised in writing that the
- 21 licensees are part of the same team and the team could have a financial interest in the
- 22 outcome of the transaction.



- 1 (B) IF A BROKER'S DESIGNEE DESIGNATES INTRACOMPANY AGENTS
 2 UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE BROKER'S DESIGNEE MAY NOT
 3 BE A MEMBER OF THE REAL ESTATE TEAM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2011.
