1 AN ACT concerning

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State Lottery Agency - Veterans Lottery - Established

- FOR the purpose of requiring the State Lottery Agency to conduct a certain number of letteries annual lottery for the benefit of the Maryland Veterans Trust Fund; requiring the Agency to deposit into the Fund a percentage of the proceeds, after certain expenses of the veterans lotteries; lottery; requiring the Agency to meet certain advertising criteria in conducting the veterans lotteries; lottery; and generally relating to lotteries conducted by the State Lottery Agency.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
