1 AN ACT concerning

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Homeowner's Insurance - Model Information - People's Insurance Counsel

- FOR the purpose of requiring that the People's Insurance Counsel Division shall have access to certain information in certain insurer filings concerning rates, issuance, and renewal of homeowner's insurance; requiring the Division to maintain the confidentiality of certain information; and generally relating to homeowner's insurance, risk planning models, and the People's Insurance Counsel Division.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Insurance
- 17 19–211.
- 18 (a) (1) If an insurer uses a catastrophic risk planning model or other 19 model in setting homeowner's insurance rates or refusing to issue or renew
- 20 homeowner's insurance because of the geographic location of the risk, the insurer
- 21 shall:
- 22 (i) file with the Commissioner a description of the specific
- 23 model used in setting the rate or refusing to issue or renew homeowner's insurance
- because of the geographic location of the risk; and



1	(ii) make arrangements for the vendor of the model to explain to
2	the Commissioner the data used in the model and the manner in which the output is
3	obtained.

- 4 (2) If at any time an insurer changes the catastrophic risk planning 5 model or other model upon which it is relying, the insurer shall notify the 6 Commissioner of the change and comply with paragraph (1) of this subsection.
- 7 (b) If the People's Insurance Counsel Division determines 8 That the interests of insurance consumers are affected by an 9 Insurer filing that uses a catastrophic risk planning model or 10 Other model, the Division shall have full access to filings made 11 Under Subsection (a) of this section.
- 12 **(C) (1)** The information filed under subsection (a) of this section is proprietary and confidential commercial information under § 10–617(d) of the State Government Article.
- 15 (2) THE PEOPLE'S INSURANCE COUNSEL DIVISION SHALL
 16 MAINTAIN THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF ANY PROPRIETARY AND CONFIDENTIAL
 17 COMMERCIAL INFORMATION TO WHICH THE DIVISION OBTAINS ACCESS UNDER
 18 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- 19 **[(c)] (D)** The Commissioner may adopt regulations to implement the 20 provisions of this section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2011.
