Prince George's County - Charitable Gaming - Poker Events

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a certain organization that promotes the arts and $\mathbf{5}$ preserves the culture in Prince George's County and certain volunteer fire 6 departments in the county to hold poker events in which the public may play 7 poker card games; limiting the number of poker events that an organization or 8 fire department may hold; requiring that an organization or fire department 9 obtain a permit from the Prince George's County Department of Environmental Resources before holding a poker event; specifying that the conditions under 10 which a permit for a poker event is issued shall be the same with certain 11 12exceptions that apply to a charitable gaming permit under the Prince George's 13 County Code; and generally relating to charitable gaming in Prince George's County. 14
