#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Motor Vehicle Administration – Documents and Records – Use of Mailing Address

- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a current or former State's Attorney, deputy State's  $\mathbf{5}$ Attorney, assistant State's Attorney, member of the judiciary of the State, 6 United States Marshal, special agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, or  $\mathbf{7}$ certain current or former law enforcement officers to provide a mailing address 8 in lieu of a residence address on any application or other official document of the 9 Motor Vehicle Administration; requiring the Administration, on the request of a certain individual, to ensure that only the individual's mailing address is 10 11 printed on any official document or public record produced by the 12Administration; authorizing the Administration to adopt certain regulations to 13carry out the provisions of this Act; defining a certain term; and generally 14 relating to the use of a mailing address for certain individuals in lieu of a 15residence address on certain documents and public records of the Motor Vehicle 16 Administration.
