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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Employees' Retirement and Pension Systems – Reemployment of Retirees –**  
3 **Health Care Practitioners**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing the termination provision applicable to certain  
5 reemployment of retirees in the Employees' Retirement and Pension Systems;  
6 and generally relating to the reemployment of retirees in the Employees'  
7 Retirement and Pension Systems.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
9 Article – State Personnel and Pensions  
10 Section 22–406(c)(4)(viii) and 23–407(c)(4)(vi)  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement)

13 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
14 Chapter 473 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2009  
15 Section 2

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – State Personnel and Pensions**

19 22–406.

20 (c) (4) Except for an individual whose allowance is subject to a reduction  
21 as provided under paragraphs (1)(iii) and (3) of this subsection, the reduction of an  
22 allowance under this subsection does not apply to:

23 (viii) a retiree of the Employees' Retirement System who is  
24 reemployed on a contractual basis by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene
