AN ACT concerning
Vehicle Laws - Dealers - Licensing and Temporary Registration Plates
FOR the purpose of altering the number of vehicles that a person may sell during a certain time period before being included under the defined term "dealer" as the term applies to certain provisions of the vehicle law; repealing a certain provision of law that requires a motor vehicle dealer that issues temporary registration plates to apply for at least a certain number of the temporary registration plates; and generally relating to vehicle dealers.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Transportation
Section 11-111 and 13-601
Annotated Code of Maryland (2009 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article - Transportation

11-111.

"Dealer" means a person who is in the business of buying, selling, or exchanging vehicles including a person who during any 12 -month period offers to sell [five] THREE or more vehicles, the ownership of which was acquired for resale purposes.

13-601.
(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Administration may design temporary registration plates and furnish them to any licensed dealer who:
(1) [On] APPLIES ON the form that the Administration requires[, applies for at least five of these plates]; and
(2) With the application, submits a fee established by the Administration for each plate.
(b) A wholesale dealer may not apply for temporary registration plates.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
