- 19 (7) Any activity conducted on a single lot of any size or a linear project 20 provided that:
- 21 (i) The activity does not result in the cutting, clearing, or 22 grading of more than [20,000] **40,000** square feet of forest; and



	(ii)	The activity on the lot or linear project will not result in the
cutting, clearing,	or gra	ding of any forest that is subject to the requirements of a
previous forest co	nserva	tion plan prepared under this subtitle;

- (9) Any activity required for the purpose of constructing a dwelling house intended for the use of the owner, or a child **OR GRANDCHILD** of the owner, if the activity does not result in the cutting, clearing, or grading of more than [20,000] **40,000** square feet of forest;
