BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Election Law 13 14 10-301.1. 15 (a) Except as provided under Title 9, Subtitle 3 of this article, during any 16 regularly scheduled primary or general election a voter may vote: 17 (1) in the voter's assigned precinct on election day; or 18 (2)at an early voting center in the voter's county of residence on any 19 early voting day in accordance with this section. 20 (b) (1)Each county shall have at least one early voting center established 21 in the county as prescribed in this subsection.

- 1 (g) Except as expressly provided in this section, any provision of this article that applies to voting on election day also applies to early voting.
- 3 (h) The State Board shall adopt regulations and guidelines in accordance 4 with the requirements of this section for the conduct of early voting.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2011.
