1 AN ACT concerning

2 Criminal Procedure – Retention of Right to Expungement – Charges Not 3 Resulting in Conviction

FOR the purpose of establishing that whether a person is entitled to expungement of one charge arising from an incident, transaction, or set of facts does not affect the person's right to expungement of another charge or conviction arising from the same incident, transaction, or set of facts; making certain conforming changes; making a certain technical correction; and generally relating to the expungement of criminal charges.

19 (a) [(1)] In this subtitle, if two or more charges **OR CONVICTIONS**, other 20 than one for a minor traffic violation, arise from the same incident, transaction, or set 21 of facts, they are considered to be a unit.

22 [(2) A charge for a minor traffic violation that arises from the same 23 incident, transaction, or set of facts as a charge in the unit is not a part of the unit.]

1 (b) (1) **[If] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS** 2 **SUBSECTION, IF** a person is not entitled to expungement of one [charge or] conviction 3 in a unit, the person is not entitled to expungement of any other [charge or] conviction 4 in the unit.

5 (2) [The disposition of a charge] A CONVICTION for a minor traffic 6 violation [that arises from the same incident, transaction, or set of facts as a charge in 7 the unit] does not affect any right to expungement of [a] ANOTHER charge or 8 conviction in the unit.

9 (C) WHETHER A PERSON IS ENTITLED TO EXPUNGEMENT OF ONE 10 CHARGE IN A UNIT DOES NOT AFFECT ANY RIGHT TO EXPUNGEMENT OF ANY 11 OTHER CHARGE OR CONVICTION IN THE UNIT.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect13 October 1, 2011.
