- 2 (a) The Chief Judge of the District Court is the chief administrative officer of the District Court and responsible for the maintenance, administration, and operation of the court in all its locations throughout the State.
- 5 (b) The Chief Judge of the District Court may make administrative 6 regulations for the governing of the District Court, subject to and not inconsistent with 7 the rules of the Court of Appeals.
- 8 (d) In addition to the powers and duties granted and imposed in subsections 9 (a), (b), and (c) of this section, or elsewhere by law or rule, the Chief Judge of the 10 District Court shall:
 - (11) Authorize a citation to include a summons to appear; [and]
- 12 (12) Cause the District Court to print or otherwise make available 13 uniform motor vehicle citation forms and any other uniform statewide citation forms 14 for offenses triable in the District Court; AND
- 15 (13) CAUSE THE DISTRICT COURT TO TRANSMIT AN ELECTRONIC
 16 COPY OF ANY JUDGMENT FOR POSSESSION ENTERED OR ANY WARRANT OF
 17 RESTITUTION ISSUED UNDER § 8–401 OF THE REAL PROPERTY ARTICLE WHEN
 18 ENTERED OR ISSUED BY THE DISTRICT COURT TO THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE OF
 19 THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PROPERTY IS LOCATED.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
