- 16 SECTION 13. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
- 17 (3) (i) \$15,200,000 for the following projects initially approved by the 18 Senate:
- (H) Carroll Mansion Museum. Provide a grant equal to the lesser
  of (i) \$75,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund
  provided, to the Board of Directors of the Carroll Museums,
  Inc. for the acquisition of heating, ventilating, and air
  conditioning equipment, and for the repair and renovation of
  the Carroll Mansion Museum, located in Baltimore City,
  subject to a requirement that the grantee grant and convey an

1 historic easement to the Maryland Historical Trust.  $\mathbf{2}$ Notwithstanding Section 13(5) of this Act, the matching fund 3 may consist of in kind contributions. NOTWITHSTANDING 4 ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE PROCEEDS OF THE  $\mathbf{5}$ LOAN MUST BE ENCUMBERED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC 6 WORKS OR EXPENDED FOR THE PURPOSES PROVIDED IN  $\overline{7}$ THIS ACT NO LATER THAN JUNE 1, 2013 (Baltimore City)... 75,000
