5 (b) (1) [For] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 6 SUBSECTION, FOR the renewal of a noncommercial Class A, B, C, D, E, or M driver's 7 license, a licensee shall pay the Administration a renewal fee established by the 8 Administration.

9 (2) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT CHARGE A LICENSEE WHO IS 10 A RECIPIENT OF THE MEDAL OF HONOR A FEE FOR THE RENEWAL OF THE 11 LICENSEE'S NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS A, B, C, D, E, OR M DRIVER'S LICENSE.
