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Election Law - Absentee Ballots

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a voter to designate a duly authorized agent to 4 complete certain acts for the voter regarding absentee ballots; requiring a voter 5 to designate a duly authorized agent of the voter if the individual is directed to 6 complete certain acts for the voter regarding absentee ballots; specifying that a 7 voter is not required to designate a duly authorized agent if the individual is 8 only returning the voter's completed absentee ballot; altering the affidavit 9 requirements for a duly authorized agent of a voter; prohibiting certain persons 10 from directly or indirectly collecting a voter's completed absentee ballot; establishing a certain penalty; making a stylistic change; and generally relating 11 12 to absentee ballots.

1 2	(a) (1) A [qualified applicant] VOTER may designate a duly authorized agent to [pick up and deliver an absentee ballot under this subtitle]:
3 4	(I) DELIVER THE VOTER'S ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATION TO THE LOCAL BOARD;
5 6	(II) PICK UP THE VOTER'S ABSENTEE BALLOT FROM THE LOCAL BOARD AND DELIVER IT TO THE VOTER; OR
7 8	(III) RETURN THE VOTER'S COMPLETED ABSENTEE BALLOT TO THE LOCAL BOARD.
9 10	(2) A VOTER SHALL DESIGNATE A DULY AUTHORIZED AGENT IF THE INDIVIDUAL SIMULTANEOUSLY IS DIRECTED TO:
11 12	(I) DELIVER THE VOTER'S ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATION TO THE LOCAL BOARD; AND
13 14	(II) PICK UP THE VOTER'S ABSENTEE BALLOT FROM THE LOCAL BOARD AND DELIVER IT TO THE VOTER.
15 16 17	(3) A VOTER IS NOT REQUIRED TO DESIGNATE A DULY AUTHORIZED AGENT IF THE INDIVIDUAL ONLY RETURNS THE VOTER'S COMPLETED ABSENTEE BALLOT TO THE LOCAL BOARD.
18	(b) [An] A DULY AUTHORIZED agent of the voter under this section:
19	(1) must be at least 18 years old;
20	(2) may not be a candidate on [that] THE VOTER'S ballot;
21 22	(3) shall be designated in a writing signed by the voter under penalty of perjury; and
23 24 25 26	(4) shall execute an affidavit under penalty of perjury that the AGENT MEETS THE CRITERIA REQUIRED BY THIS SUBSECTION FOR SERVING AS AN AGENT AND WILL FAITHFULLY PERFORM THE TASKS DESIGNATED BY THE VOTER [ballot was:
27	(i) delivered to the voter who submitted the application;
28 29	(ii) marked and placed in an envelope by the voter, or with assistance as allowed by regulation, in the agent's presence; and

3 4 5	(A) THE FOLLOWING PERSONS MAY NOT DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY COLLECT A VOTER'S COMPLETED ABSENTEE BALLOT FOR DELIVERY TO THE LOCAL BOARD:
6	(1) A CANDIDATE;
7	(2) A POLITICAL PARTY;
8 9	(3) A PERSON SUPPORTING OR OPPOSING AN ISSUE ON THE BALLOT; OR
10 11 12	(4) A PERSON DIRECTED BY OR WORKING ON BEHALF OF A CANDIDATE, POLITICAL PARTY, OR A PERSON SUPPORTING OR OPPOSING AN ISSUE ON THE BALLOT.
13 14 15	(B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$50 NOR MORE THAN \$500 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 60 DAYS OR BOTH.
16 17	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
