1 AN ACT concerning

Elections - Candidates for Judicial Offices - Certificates of Candidacy and Campaign Finance Entities

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting, under certain circumstances, a judge from filing a $\mathbf{5}$ certificate of candidacy for judicial office more than a certain number of years 6 before the general election for the judicial office; prohibiting, under certain $\mathbf{7}$ circumstances, a judge from establishing, or causing to be established, a 8 campaign finance entity more than a certain number of years before the general 9 election for the judicial office; providing for the application of this Act; defining a certain term; and generally relating to certificates of candidacy and campaign 10 finance entities for candidates for certain judicial offices. 11

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) [and (c)], (C), AND (D) of this 22 section, a certificate of candidacy shall be filed not later than 9 p.m. on the Monday 23 that is 10 weeks or 70 days before the day on which the primary election will be held.

later than 5 p.m. on the Monday that is 3 weeks or 21 days prior to the date for the
special primary election specified by the Governor in the proclamation for the special
primary election.

- 4 (c) The certificate of candidacy for the election of a write-in candidate shall 5 be filed by the earlier of:
- 6 (1) 7 days after a total expenditure of at least \$51 is made to promote 7 the candidacy by a campaign finance entity of the candidate; or
- 8 (2) 5 p.m. on the Wednesday preceding the day of the election for 9 which the certificate is filed.
