2 Maryland Health Care Commission – Certificate of Need Requirements

FOR the purpose of expanding the application of certain certificate of need requirements relating to the closure or partial closure of a hospital to certain other health care facilities; authorizing the Maryland Health Care Commission to require a certain health care facility to hold a certain hearing in a certain location; requiring the hearing to be held in consultation with the Commission and within a certain time period; and generally relating to certificate of need requirements and the Maryland Health Care Commission.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 (l) (1) A certificate of need is not required to close any [hospital] HEALTH 2 CARE FACILITY or part of a [hospital] HEALTH CARE FACILITY [as defined in § 3 19-301 of this title] if[:

4 (1) At] AT least 45 days before the closing or partial closing of [a 5 hospital] THE HEALTH CARE FACILITY, including a State hospital, a person 6 proposing to close all or part of the [hospital] HEALTH CARE FACILITY files notice of 7 the proposed closing or partial closing with the Commission[; and].

8 (2) [For a] A hospital located in a county with fewer than three 9 hospitals THAT FILES A NOTICE OF ITS PROPOSED CLOSING OR PARTIAL 10 CLOSING WITH THE COMMISSION[, within 30 days after receipt of the notice of 11 intent to close, the hospital, in consultation with the Commission, holds] SHALL HOLD 12 a public informational hearing in the county where the hospital is located.

13 (3) THE COMMISSION MAY REQUIRE A HEALTH CARE FACILITY
14 OTHER THAN A HOSPITAL DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION
15 THAT FILES NOTICE OF ITS PROPOSED CLOSING OR PARTIAL CLOSING TO HOLD
16 A PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL HEARING IN THE COUNTY WHERE THE HEALTH CARE
17 FACILITY IS LOCATED.

18 (4) A PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL HEARING REQUIRED UNDER 19 PARAGRAPH (2) OR (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE HELD BY THE HEALTH 20 CARE FACILITY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSION, WITHIN **30** DAYS 21 AFTER THE HEALTH CARE FACILITY FILES A NOTICE OF ITS PROPOSED CLOSING 22 OR PARTIAL CLOSING WITH THE COMMISSION.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
