## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2010 – Prince George’s County**  
3 **– Largo High School PTSA Track Renovation**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2010  
5 to reduce the amount of a matching fund a certain grantee must provide;  
6 changing the name of a certain grantee to the Prince George’s County Board of  
7 Education; extending the deadline for a certain grantee to present evidence that  
8 a matching fund will be provided; making this Act an emergency measure; and  
9 requiring that the Board of Public Works expend or encumber the proceeds of  
10 the loan by June 1, ~~2013~~ 2012.

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
12 Chapter 483 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2010  
13 Section 1(3) Item ZA02(BH)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

1 (BH) Largo High School PTSA Track Renovation. Provide a grant  
 2 [equal to the lesser of (i)] **OF** \$180,000 [or (ii) the amount of  
 3 the matching fund provided], to the [Largo High School  
 4 Parent Teacher Association] **PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY**  
 5 **BOARD OF EDUCATION** for the planning, design,  
 6 construction, repair, renovation, and reconstruction of the  
 7 Largo High School Track, located in Largo, **SUBJECT TO A**  
 8 **REQUIREMENT THAT THE GRANTEE PROVIDE AND**  
 9 **EXPEND A MATCHING FUND OF \$90,000.** Notwithstanding  
 10 Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund may consist of real  
 11 property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the  
 12 effective date of this Act. **NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION**  
 13 **1(5) OF THIS ACT, THE GRANTEE HAS UNTIL JUNE 1,**  
 14 **~~2013~~ 2012, TO PRESENT EVIDENCE THAT A MATCHING**  
 15 **FUND WILL BE PROVIDED. NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION**  
 16 **1(7) OF THIS ACT, THE PROCEEDS OF THE LOAN MUST BE**  
 17 **EXPENDED OR ENCUMBERED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC**  
 18 **WORKS FOR THE PURPOSES PROVIDED IN THIS ACT NO**  
 19 **LATER THAN JUNE 1, ~~2013~~ 2012** (Prince George’s County) . 180,000

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency  
 21 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,  
 22 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members  
 23 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from  
 24 the date it is enacted.
