A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2010 – Prince George’s County**
3 **– Forestville Military Academy Track**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2010
5 to reduce the amount of a matching fund a certain grantee must provide;
6 changing the name of a certain grantee to the Prince George’s County Board of
7 Education; extending the deadline for a certain grantee to present evidence that
8 a matching fund will be provided; making this Act an emergency measure; and
9 requiring that the Board of Public Works expend or encumber the proceeds of
10 the loan by June 1, 2013.

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
12 Chapter 483 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2010
13 Section 1(3) Item ZA02(BE)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Chapter 483 of the Acts of 2010**

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That:

19 (3) ZA02 LOCAL SENATE INITIATIVES

20 (BE) Forestville Military Academy Track. Provide a grant [equal to
21 the lesser of (i)] OF \$180,000 [or (ii) the amount of the
22 matching fund provided], to the [Forestville High School
23 PTA] **PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION**
24 for the planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, and
25 reconstruction of the Forestville Military Academy Track,

1 located in Forestville, **SUBJECT TO A REQUIREMENT THAT**
 2 **THE GRANTEE PROVIDE AND EXPEND A MATCHING FUND**
 3 **OF \$90,000.** Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of this Act, the
 4 matching fund may consist of real property, in kind
 5 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of
 6 this Act. **NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 1(5) OF THIS ACT,**
 7 **THE GRANTEE HAS UNTIL JUNE 1, 2013, TO PRESENT**
 8 **EVIDENCE THAT A MATCHING FUND WILL BE PROVIDED.**
 9 **NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 1(7) OF THIS ACT, THE**
 10 **PROCEEDS OF THE LOAN MUST BE EXPENDED OR**
 11 **ENCUMBERED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR**
 12 **THE PURPOSES PROVIDED IN THIS ACT NO LATER THAN**
 13 **JUNE 1, 2013** (Prince George’s County) 180,000

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
 15 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
 16 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
 17 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
 18 the date it is enacted.
