- 20 (IV) ONE PERSON CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF THREE
- 21 CANDIDATES SUBMITTED BY A STATE ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING DAIRY

- 23 (V) ONE PERSON CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF THREE
- 24 CANDIDATES SUBMITTED BY A STATE ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING BEEF

- 26 (VI) ONE PERSON CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF THREE
- 27 CANDIDATES SUBMITTED BY A STATE ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING POULTRY

- 29 (VII) ONE PERSON CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF THREE
- 30 CANDIDATES SUBMITTED BY A STATE ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING OVINE

- (VIII) ONE PERSON CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF THREE 1 2 CANDIDATES SUBMITTED BY A STATE ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING EQUINE 3 SPECIES: 4 (IX) ONE PERSON CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF THREE 5 CANDIDATES SUBMITTED BY A STATE ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING PORCINE 6 SPECIES: AND 7 **(X)** THREE REPRESENTATIVES FROM LIVESTOCK OR 8 POULTRY SECTORS THAT ARE INADEQUATELY REPRESENTED UNDER ITEMS (I) 9 THROUGH (IX) OF THIS PARAGRAPH. 10 OF THE MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY, EACH SHALL BE (B) 11 A RESIDENT OF THE STATE. 12 IF A REGULATED LOBBYIST IS APPOINTED TO SERVE AS A MEMBER 13 OF THE BOARD, THE LOBBYIST IS NOT SUBJECT TO: § 15–504(D) OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE; OR 14 **(1)** § 15-703(f)(3) OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE AS A 15 **(2)** 16 RESULT OF THAT SERVICE. 17 (D) **(1)** EXCEPT FOR THE INITIAL TERMS OF THE BOARD, THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 4 YEARS. 18 19 **(2)** THE TERMS OF THE INITIAL MEMBERS: 20 (I)SHALL BE STAGGERED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE 21SECRETARY; AND 22 (II) MAY NOT EXCEED 4 YEARS. 23 A MEMBER MAY SERVE CONSECUTIVE TERMS. **(3)** 24**(E) (1)** THE BOARD SHALL ELECT A CHAIR FROM AMONG ITS 25MEMBERS.

- 18 (A) THE BOARD SHALL MEET AT LEAST TWICE A YEAR AT THE
- 19 DISCRETION OF THE CHAIR.
- 20 **(B)** A MEMBER OF THE BOARD:
- 21 (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE
- 22 BOARD; BUT
- 23 (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE
- 24 STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE
