16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21	(1) Has a seat for the operator;

1 (2)Has two **OR THREE** wheels, of which one is 10 inches or more in  $\mathbf{2}$ diameter: 3 (3)**(I)** [Has] FOR A TWO–WHEEL VEHICLE, HAS a step–through 4 chassis; OR  $\mathbf{5}$ **(II)** FOR A THREE–WHEEL VEHICLE, HAS A COCKPIT; 6 (4) Has a motor: 7 (i) With a rating of 2.7 brake horsepower or less; or 8 (ii) If the motor is an internal combustion engine, with a 9 capacity of 50 cubic centimeters piston displacement or less; and 10 (5)Is equipped with an automatic transmission. 11 (b) "Motor scooter" does not include a vehicle that has been manufactured for 12off-road use, including a motorcycle and an all-terrain vehicle. 1321-1201. 14(c)With the exceptions stated in this subtitle, the provisions of this subtitle that are applicable to bicycles apply whenever a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor 15scooter is operated on any highway or whenever a bicycle or an EPAMD is operated on 1617any path set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles. 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency

19 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, 20 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members 21 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from 22 the date it is enacted.
