## Environment - Phosphorus - Commercial Dishwashing Detergent

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from using, selling, manufacturing, or distributing for <u>use or</u> sale certain commercial dishwashing detergents that contain greater than a certain amount of phosphorus after a certain date; repealing certain obsolete language; and generally relating to phosphorus in commercial dishwashing detergents.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 20 21 22 23 24	(2) AFTER JANUARY 1, 2013, A PERSON MAY NOT USE, SELL, MANUFACTURE, OR DISTRIBUTE FOR USE OR SALE WITHIN THE STATE ANY DETERGENT FOR USE IN A COMMERCIAL DISHWASHING MACHINE THAT CONTAINS MORE THAN 0.5 PERCENT PHOSPHORUS BY WEIGHT.  SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
