- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a video lottery operation licensee from directly or indirectly interfering with, hindering, obstructing, impeding, or taking any 4 5 action to delay the implementation or establishment of a video lottery facility by 6 any other video lottery operation licensee or applicant; requiring the State 7 Lottery Commission to adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of this Act; 8 requiring that the regulations adopted by the State Lottery Commission include 9 certain provisions; and generally relating to video lottery facilities and video 10 lottery operation licenses.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 1 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Commission shall ensure that a video lottery operation licensee complies with the requirements of this section as a condition of holding the video lottery operation license.
- 4 (G) (1) A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSEE MAY NOT, DIRECTLY 5 OR INDIRECTLY, INTERFERE WITH, HINDER, OBSTRUCT, IMPEDE, OR TAKE ANY 6 ACTION TO DELAY THE IMPLEMENTATION OR ESTABLISHMENT OF A VIDEO 1 LOTTERY FACILITY BY ANY OTHER LICENSEE OR APPLICANT FOR A VIDEO 1 LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE AWARDED OR ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
- 9 (2) (I) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS, TO THE 10 FULLEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY THE FIRST AMENDMENT OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES, TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION.

- 14 THAT EXPRESSLY PROHIBIT:
- A. TAKING ANY OF THE ACTIONS DESCRIBED IN

 REQUIRED STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL APPROVALS FOR THE
 ESTABLISHMENT OF A VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY; OR
- B. PROVIDING FUNDING OR OTHER MATERIAL SUPPORT TO ENGAGE IN ANY OF THE ACTIONS DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION; AND
- 22 **2.** THAT PROHIBIT, AS UNLAWFUL INDIRECT 23 CONDUCT, ACTIVITY:
- A. BY AN ENTITY IN WHICH THE LICENSEE OWNS A BENEFICIAL OR PROPRIETARY INTEREST; OR
- B. BY AN ENTITY IN WHICH AN AFFILIATE OF THE LICENSEE OWNS A BENEFICIAL OR PROPRIETARY INTEREST.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
