CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

Maryland Department of Transportation <u>and Maryland Transportation</u> <u>Authority</u> – Enhanced Inspection of Bridges – Adoption of Regulations

FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Department of Transportation, in 4 consultation with the Maryland Transportation Authority, to adopt, by a certain $\mathbf{5}$ 6 date, regulations concerning enhanced inspection of bridges in the State; 7requiring the regulations to include certain policies and practices; authorizing 8 the Maryland Department of Transportation and the Maryland Transportation 9 Authority to supplement or revise certain policies or practices for a certain 10 purpose; and generally relating to regulations governing enhanced inspection of bridges in the State. 11

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That:

14 (1) On or before December 31, 2011 July 1, 2012, the Maryland 15 Department of Transportation, in consultation with the Maryland Transportation 16 <u>Authority</u>, shall adopt regulations governing the inspection of all bridges in the State 17 to augment current visual inspection policies and practices.

18 (2) The regulations required under this section shall include policies19 and practices that:

9 10 11	(3) <u>The Maryland Department of Transportation and the Maryland</u> <u>Transportation Authority, in order to enhance safety, may supplement or revise any</u> <u>policies or practices adopted under the regulations required under this section.</u>
