- 18 (F) (1) THE TERM OF A COUNTY COMMISSIONER IS 4 YEARS.
- 19 (2) A COUNTY COMMISSIONER MAY NOT BE ELECTED TO SERVE 20 MORE THAN TWO CONSECUTIVE TERMS.
- 21 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY ON 22 THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SHALL:

(I) AT THE TIME OF APPOINTMENT AND WHILE FILLING
OUT THE UNEXPIRED TERM, RESIDE IN THE COMMISSIONER DISTRICT AS THAT
OF THE COMMISSIONER WHOSE SEAT IS VACATED; AND
(II) SERVE ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TERM AND
UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED AND QUALIFIES.
