- 4 FOR the purpose of providing that certain retirees of certain regional libraries may 5 participate in the health benefit options established under the State Employee 6 and Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits Program under certain circumstances; 7 requiring certain regional libraries to pay to the State the total costs resulting 8 from participation of the retirees of the regional libraries in the Program; 9 requiring certain regional libraries to make certain determinations about subsidizing participation of their retirees in the Program; providing that 10 11 retirees of certain regional libraries who participate in the State Employee and 12 Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits Program are subject to certain terms and 13 conditions; and generally relating to the participation of retirees of the Southern 14 Maryland Regional Library, the Eastern Shore Regional Library, and the 15 Western Maryland Regional Library in the State Employee and Retiree Health 16 and Welfare Benefits Program.

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 (a) This section applies to the Southern Maryland Regional Library, the Eastern Shore Regional Library, and the Western Maryland Regional Library.
- 3 (b) An employee **OR RETIREE** of a regional library subject to this section 4 may enroll and participate in the health insurance benefit options established under the Program with the approval of the library.
 - (c) A regional library subject to this section shall:
- 7 (1) pay to the State the total costs resulting from the participation of 8 its employees **AND RETIREES** in the Program; and
- 9 (2) determine the extent to which the regional library will subsidize 10 participation of its employees **AND RETIREES** in the Program.
- 11 (D) A RETIREE OF A REGIONAL LIBRARY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION IS
 12 SUBJECT TO THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THOSE PROVIDED UNDER §
 13 2–508 OF THIS SUBTITLE, WITH THE RETIREE'S SERVICE WITH A REGIONAL
 14 LIBRARY BEING CONSIDERED YEARS OF STATE SERVICE FOR PURPOSES OF
 15 ESTABLISHING ELIGIBILITY UNDER § 2–508(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
