#### 1 AN ACT concerning

- Vehicle Laws Registration Classifications Special Class G Farm or
  Livestock Trailer or Semitrailer
- FOR the purpose of establishing the special Class C livestock trailer or semitrailer 4  $\mathbf{5}$ motor vehicle registration classification: authorizing the Motor Vehicle 6 Administration to issue a Class G livestock trailer and semitrailer registration 7 only to an applicant who certifies that the vehicle is used exclusively to transport livestock and for a vehicle that has a certain maximum gross weight 8 9 limitation: establishing the annual registration fee for the Class G livestock 10 trailer or semitrailer: prohibiting a Class G livestock trailer or semitrailer from 11 being used for hire, subject to a certain exception, or from being used in any manner other than to haul livestock: defining a certain term; and generally 12 relating to the establishment of the special Class G livestock trailer or 13semitrailer motor vehicle registration classification altering the Class G farm 14 trailer or semitrailer motor vehicle registration classification to include a 15livestock trailer or semitrailer; authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to 16 issue a Class G farm or livestock trailer or semitrailer registration to an 1718 applicant who certifies that the applicant is a farmer, an agricultural producer, 19or a livestock exhibitor and that the vehicle is to be used for a certain purpose; 20 altering certain motor vehicle registration fees; prohibiting a Class G farm or 21livestock trailer or semitrailer from being used for hire, except under certain 22circumstances; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to a special Class G farm or livestock trailer or semitrailer motor vehicle registration 2324classification.
