12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 17	(A) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT DESIGNATE MORE THAN 25% OF THE AVAILABLE OYSTER HABITAT IN THE WATERS OF THE STATE AS OYSTER SANCTUARIES.

19 **[(a)] (B)** The Department annually shall publish maps and coordinates of 20 oyster sanctuaries, closed oyster harvest reserve areas, and areas closed to shellfish 21 harvest by the Department of the Environment.

[(b)] (C) (1) The Department shall provide the publications required under this section to each tidal fish licensee who pays the oyster surcharges required under § 4–701(e) of this title.

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- 1 (2) Before a person may catch oysters under a tidal fish license that 2 has an oyster authorization and for which the oyster surcharges have been paid, the 3 person shall certify to the Department on a form the Department prescribes that the 4 person received the publications required under this section.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2011.
