- 16 (A) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT DESIGNATE MORE THAN 25% OF THE
- 17 AVAILABLE QUALITY OYSTER HABITAT IN THE WATERS OF THE STATE AS
- 18 OYSTER SANCTUARIES, UNLESS THE DEPARTMENT CONDUCTS A PUBLIC
- 19 HEARING DURING WHICH IT PRESENTS SCIENTIFIC EVIDENCE OF A SIGNIFICANT
- 20 INCREASE IN THE HARVESTABLE OYSTER POPULATION.

4 5 6	[(b)] (C) (1) The Department shall provide the publications required under this section to each tidal fish licensee who pays the oyster surcharges required under § 4–701(e) of this title.
7 8 9 10	(2) Before a person may catch oysters under a tidal fish license that has an oyster authorization and for which the oyster surcharges have been paid, the person shall certify to the Department on a form the Department prescribes that the person received the publications required under this section.
11 12	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
