Health Insurance - Limit on Copayments

FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain insurers, nonprofit health service plans, and
health maintenance organizations that provide covered benefits subject to a
copayment from imposing a copayment that exceeds a specified percentage of
the allowed amount established for the covered benefit; establishing a certain
exception; making certain provisions of this Act applicable to health
maintenance organizations; providing for the application of this Act; and
generally relating to health insurance and copayments for covered benefits.

1 (1) INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT 2 PROVIDE HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR 3 GROUPS ON AN EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS UNDER HEALTH INSURANCE 4 POLICIES OR CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND

5 (2) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE 6 HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS 7 UNDER CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.

8 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, AN 9 ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION THAT PROVIDES COVERED BENEFITS 10 SUBJECT TO A COPAYMENT MAY NOT IMPOSE A COPAYMENT THAT EXCEEDS **50**% 11 OF THE ALLOWED AMOUNT ESTABLISHED BY THE ENTITY FOR THE COVERED 12 BENEFIT.
