Public Health - Cord Blood Transplant Program Support Fund

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Cord Blood Transplant Program Support Fund; 4 providing for the purpose of the Fund; requiring the Department of Health and 5 Mental Hygiene to administer the Fund; specifying that the Fund is a special, 6 nonlapsing fund that is not subject to a certain provision of law; requiring the 7 State Treasurer to hold the fund separately and invest and reinvest money in 8 the Fund in a certain manner; requiring the State Comptroller to account for 9 the Fund; specifying that the Fund consists of certain money, and that investment earnings be paid into the Fund; specifying the purposes for which 10 11 the Fund may be used; specifying that expenditures from the Fund may be 12 made only in accordance with the State budget; authorizing certain qualified 13 medical institutions to apply for a certain grant from the Fund each year; 14 requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; 15 and generally relating to the Cord Blood Transplant Program Support Fund.

- 3 (B) "CORD BLOOD TRANSPLANT PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM THAT USES CELLS OBTAINED FROM A HUMAN UMBILICAL CORD OR PLACENTA TO
- 5 TREAT PEDIATRIC OR ADULT PATIENTS AFFLICTED WITH A DISEASE OR INJURY.
- 6 (C) "FUND" MEANS THE CORD BLOOD TRANSPLANT PROGRAM
 7 SUPPORT FUND.

- 6 (H) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST AND REINVEST THE 7 MONEY OF THE FUND IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE 8 INVESTED.
- 9 (2) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL PAID INTO 10 THE FUND.
- 11 (I) (1) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL PAY OUT MONEY FROM THE FUND 12 AS DIRECTED BY THE SECRETARY.
- 13 (2) NO PART OF THE FUND MAY REVERT OR BE CREDITED TO:
- 14 (I) THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE; OR
- 15 (II) ANY OTHER SPECIAL FUND OF THE STATE.
- 16 (J) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
