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Public Health - Cord Blood Transplant Program Support Fund

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Cord Blood Transplant Program Support Fund; in 4 the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene for certain purposes; 5 establishing the Cord Blood Transplant Center Support Fund; providing for the 6 purpose of the Fund; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene 7 to administer the Fund; specifying that the Fund is a special, nonlapsing fund 8 that is not subject to a certain provision of law; requiring the State Treasurer to 9 hold the fund separately and invest and reinvest money in the Fund in a certain 10 manner; requiring the State Comptroller to account for the Fund; specifying that the Fund consists of certain money, and that investment earnings be paid 11 12 into the Fund; specifying the purposes for which the Fund may be used; 13 specifying that expenditures from the Fund may be made only in accordance 14 with the State budget; authorizing certain qualified medical institutions to apply for a certain grant from the Fund each year; requiring the Department to 15 adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the 16 17 Cord Blood Transplant Program Center Support Fund.
