A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Education – Residential Boarding Education Programs for At–Risk Youth – 3 Funding

FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to appropriate certain funds to the State Department of Education to cover the transportation, boarding, and administrative costs of residential boarding education programs for at-risk youth; limiting the total amount of funds to an amount adequate to fund a certain maximum number of students; defining certain terms; and generally relating to funding for residential boarding education programs for at-risk youth.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 (a) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 21 MEANINGS INDICATED.

22 (2) "CHANGE IN THE PER PUPIL AMOUNT" MEANS THE CHANGE 23 IN THE PER PUPIL FOUNDATION AMOUNT FROM THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR TO 24 THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR DIVIDED BY THE PER PUPIL FOUNDATION AMOUNT 25 FROM THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR.



1 (3) "PER PUPIL ALLOCATION" MEANS THE PER PUPIL FIGURE 2 CALCULATED EACH FISCAL YEAR UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION TO 3 COVER THE TRANSPORTATION, BOARDING, AND ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS OF A 4 PROGRAM.

5 (4) "PER PUPIL FOUNDATION AMOUNT" MEANS THE FIGURE 6 CALCULATED FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR BY THE DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE 7 WITH § 5–202 OF THIS ARTICLE.

8 **(B)** In addition to the funds disbursed in accordance with § 8–709 of this 9 subtitle, the Governor shall appropriate funds to the Department in accordance with 10 this section to cover the transportation, boarding, and administrative costs of a 11 program.

12 [(b)] (C) (1) Subject to paragraph [(3)] (4) of this subsection, beginning 13 in fiscal year 2009, the Governor shall appropriate at least \$2,000,000 to the 14 Department in order for a program to serve up to 80 students.

15 (2) For **FISCAL YEARS 2010 THROUGH 2012, FOR** each additional 10 16 students enrolled in a program, as reported by the Department, the Governor shall 17 appropriate an additional \$250,000.

18 (3) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2013, FOR EACH STUDENT 19 ENROLLED IN A PROGRAM, AS REPORTED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE 20 GOVERNOR SHALL APPROPRIATE:

(I) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013, AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF AT
 LEAST \$25,000 MULTIPLIED BY THE CHANGE IN THE PER PUPIL AMOUNT PLUS
 ONE; AND

(II) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR
THEREAFTER, AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT THAT IS AT LEAST EQUAL TO THE PRIOR
YEAR PER PUPIL AMOUNT MULTIPLIED BY THE CHANGE IN THE PER PUPIL
AMOUNT PLUS ONE.

- (4) The total amount of funds appropriated under this subsection may
 not exceed [\$10,000,000] AN AMOUNT ADEQUATE TO FUND THE PER PUPIL
 ALLOCATION FOR 400 STUDENTS for any fiscal year.
- 31 [(c)] (D) This section may not be construed to prohibit a program from 32 receiving funds from private, federal, or other sources.

33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 34 July 1, 2011.
