- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 (2) "CHANGE IN THE PER PUPIL AMOUNT" MEANS THE CHANGE 4 IN THE PER PUPIL FOUNDATION AMOUNT FROM THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR TO 5 THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR DIVIDED BY THE PER PUPIL FOUNDATION AMOUNT
- 6 FROM THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR.
- 7 (3) "PER PUPIL ALLOCATION" MEANS THE PER PUPIL FIGURE 8 CALCULATED EACH FISCAL YEAR UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION TO 9 COVER THE TRANSPORTATION, BOARDING, AND ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS OF A 10 PROGRAM.

[(c)] (D) This section may not be construed to prohibit a program fro receiving funds from private, federal, or other sources.
